Elite Football Experience: Throughout a career in elite professional football, both in the domestic game and at international level, I have accumulated a wealth of experience and knowledge within a high-performance sporting environment across many different football environments and cultures through roles in Cyprus, India, Greece, England, Sudan, Rwanda, Malawi and Nepal.

High Performance Sports Leadership: Over the course of my professional coaching career, I have amassed vast knowledge and experience managing and leading elite players and high-performance multidisciplinary staff. My methodology and philosophy have contributed to the development and progression of players, club teams and national associations.

Programme Planning: Proficient in the design and implementation of forward-thinking and creative technical and tactical performance programmes which have contributed to tangible on-field success at various clubs across the globe and also on the international stage. Nepal won the Silver Medal in the South Asian Football Federation Championship, India won the 2018 Intercontinental Cup, while Rwanda progressed from 135 in the FIFA World Rankings to an all-time high of 64.

Financial Management: Within the various Head Coach roles I have demonstrated the ability to prudently manage the players and coaching staff budget to ensure the club get value for money within player and coach recruitment to enable on-field progression within their financial means.

Communication: I utilise strong interpersonal skills to facilitate an effective line of communication between club owners, board members and club or national association colleagues, as well as players and coaching staff.

Football Analytics: Utilise football analysis software and expertise to study training, games and opposition to identify areas of strengths and areas of improvement, provide structured feedback to further develop and support players.

Club Infrastructure: My role as a Head Coach was not limited to the playing side but I would use my experience to build the infrastructure of the club, including the establishment of key departments to enable their progression.
